Campbell Avenue Enhancements Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Q. What are the project limits?

A. The project limits begin at Grant Road to the south and end at Fort Lowell Road to the north.

Q. What are some of the features of the design?

A. The enhancements will include improved crossings at the side streets including new ramps, decorative pavers and stamped crosswalks; 3 monument signs at Campbell & Glenn intersection; landscape features

Q. What types of landscape features are proposed?

A. Two features are proposed: Landscaped median islands and above ground planters. The plant material is based on the selected landscape design.

Q. What are landscaped median islands?

A. The median islands are sections of raised curb that are 20 feet long and 12 feet wide. There are eight (8) proposed locations in the center of the roadway.

Q. What are above ground planters?

A. The planters will be three (3) pots of varied sizes (2ft, 3ft and 4ft in diameter) located at various intersection corners behind the access ramps.

Q. Will there be a continuous sidewalk along the corridor?

A. Where right-of-way permits, the project will include new sections of sidewalk. Additionally, broken sections of sidewalk will be repaired.

Q. What is the schedule for this project?

A. The main components of the design are complete. TDOT is currently including additional design features at the request of the public. A funding request package needs to be submitted to ADOT no later than April 2014.

Q. When will construction begin?

A. It is anticipated the funding authorization will not be received until late 2014. Construction would then be delayed until 2015.

Q. What is the budget for this project?

A. The total budget for this project is \$1,063,000 and is a combination of Federal Earmark Funds, Federal Transportation Enhancement Funds and City Local Match.

Q. What is the budget for construction?

A. There is currently \$643,000 available for construction of the Campbell Avenue Enhancements.

Q. How long will this area be under construction?

A. A project of this size and scale should take approximately 90 days to construct.

Q. What has been done to minimize the impact to surrounding merchants, residents and commuters?

A. Through feedback from the Campbell Avenue Business Partnership, a window for construction has been identified as being the summer months of June through September.
