9-??: Prepare and maintain neighborhood map to show locations of key personnel and to coordinate outreach activities such as alleys that need cleaning, location of activities, etc.

10-MG: Coordinate with Ward 3 City Council Aide CJ.Boyd@TucsonAZ.com on COT support and inter-neighborhood communications, especially w.r.t. Grant Road widening, policy changes, and activities.

Finances:

1-BE: Change EIN with Chase (done).

2-MG: Must file IRS form 990 each year to maintain account; identify *pro bono* options within CGNE.

3-KA: Expand dues payment methods to include as many automated payment services as possible (PayPal, Venmo, Zelle, etc.) and facilitate using the CGNE website. Verify that donators <u>are/are not</u> charged a fee for one-time credit card donations (MG made \$120 donation on 5/8/2022 [\$10/month] to test.)?

4-KA: Ask Chase to remove minimum balance requirement, or change to bank/credit union that provides such a service for neighborhoods.
